Shade 3D Pro version 14 for Mac

3D

Shade 3D Pro version 14 for Mac is the latest version of one of the oldest and respected 3D software programs, and one of the most popular, with an estimated 200,000 users worldwide. The significant number of file import and export formats makes the program adaptable for a number of workflows in modeling, animation, architecture, and wide format and 3D printing. The program is capable of producing amazing, photorealistic images, models, and animations that are worthy of the best Hollywood productions.


3D printing users will appreciate that the program can both import and export in the .stl file format, as well as provide optimized printed output. Text objects can be derived from any Type I or OpenType font, with control over position, extrusion depth, and spacing.

New in version 14 is the Line Offset tool that can use any existing line and make multiple copies that are offset a precise distance, in a variety of line styles. Other innovations in this version are: support for 3D passive polarized monitors, for viewing in 3D stereo; a Line Thickness tool that enables adjusting the thickness of line objects, such as curved surfaces and polygon meshes; and much more.

Rendering time can be reduced up to 40% or more using Quality Optimization, wherein the user can individually adjust the quality of light sources and surface materials, and make other adjustments in quality levels.

The Shade environment conforms to the standard basic layout of typical 3D programs, with a choice of views in the center of the screen, tools and primitives on the left, settings on the right, and menus along the top. It is, nonetheless, a very sophisticated and complex environment that can pose a significant learning curve. Learn 3D with Cheetah 3D 6, a book available in a variety of e-formats, as well as print, is the best available text for learning the features, capabilities, and creative processes in Cheetah 3D 6. Now in its second edition, with an amazing 661 illustrations, this book is the definitive resource for learning this sophisticated 3D program environment.

Silhouette Connect enables users of compatible versions of Adobe Illustrator and CorelDRAW to easily transfer designs produced in those programs for use in a Silhouette electronic cutting machine. Although Silhouette publishes design software, those familiar with the aforementioned programs may have a higher comfort and expertise level working in a program that they know.

After a job has been created in the host application, and any bitmaps have been converted to vectors, the job is sent to Silhouette Connect, where the job can be previewed and cut settings can be adjusted. Rulers help to position the job on the targeted media, and the page size can be adjusted as needed. A palette of navigation tools are provided for panning and zooming.

Specific cut settings can be selected dealing with page properties, cutting mat settings, and cut conditions. The user can elect to cut by selected color, add momentary pauses to change from a blade to a pen, adjust the blade speed and pressure, auto weld overlapping shapes, apply registration marks for print and cut jobs, and more. The Weed settings menu, enables the options for applying and adjusting a weed border if necessary, to make the removal of excess material easier.

After the settings have been made, the job can be sent directly to the Silhouette cutting machine that is connected to the computer. Commonly used settings can be maintained by setting preferences. \$39.99

This new version adds four important features: Home Network Security, which monitors users' Wi-Fi and router connections; Secure DNS, which protects against unknowingly being diverted to a fake site; Improved Web Shield, which now scans HTTPS sites for malware and threats; and SmartScan, which launches all scans (threats, updates, home network issues, and PC performance) with a single click.


Avast 2015 seeks to prevent intrusive and harmful downloads by providing a hardware-assisted virtualization test area to segregate suspicious downloads. In addition, the PUP (Potentially Unwanted Programs) feature is more easily activated, and ensures that users are not burdened with software that is not necessarily malware, but that can harm their computer's performance.

In response to user concerns about time-consuming program updates, the user now has the option of having updates automatically downloaded in the background, before the user is notified of their presence. Once the notification is sent, the user can perform an update in as little as one minute, instead of the usual 15. In addition, popular third-party software updates are now available directly from Avast servers, using the Avast Software Updater.

Through the Avast on-line forum, or by contacting customer support directly, all Avast users, both free and paid, receive support. When such a site is accessed it will open in the SafeZone browser, with options to never open for this site, always open for this site, or only open in SafeZone this one time.

Other features include: Data Shredder, to permanently wipe out financial or mission-critical data so that it can not be retrieved; Anti-Spam, which filters out potential threats lurking in emails; DeepScreen 2.0, which is a cloud-based machine learning engine that can detect malware and quarantine it before it can cause harm; Hardening Mode, which blocks files from executing if it has not been determined if they are infected; Streaming Updates, as many as one every six minutes, which protect against the latest malware; and Rescue Disk, which can restore a PC to normal functioning following an infection.

Folders Synchronizer 4 ensures that pairs of files, folders, or disks are in complete synchronization. Each back-up session provides multiple options for accomplishing the exact specifications for the sync, including times, preview, multiple folders, filters, excluded items, session log, etc. Synchronizations can be completed either as incremental or exact copies, including locked files.

During a Backup, the source folder remains unchanged, and the destination folder will be upgraded to the newest files and folders copied from the source. During an *incremental backup*, which is the default, no items are ever deleted. During an *exact backup*, items that no longer exist in the source folder are deleted.

During a synchronization, old files, and folders, in both the source and destination are replaced with the newest versions. Folders will be updated with the latest files, leaving unchanged files as they were. In an exact synchronization all items that do not exist in the mirror folder are deleted. In an incremental synchronization, which is the default, items are never deleted from a folder.

During either a backup or a synchronization, up to 32 pairs of folders, disks, or files can be specified. Filters can be applied to exempt files and folders on the basis of file name, file size, creation date, etc. This is an invaluable tool for every digital publisher. \$40

Wondershare AllMyMusic for Mac provides a super-easy interface for recording and identifying music that is played on a Macintosh, from virtually any streaming source, such as iTunes, Pandora, Spotify, Napster, Rhapsody, Yahoo Music, etc., with no user intervention. The program, which has been successfully tested on more than 500 radio stations and online music sites, automatically captures the audio source, in MP3 or M4A (AAC) format, and in one of two quality levels (256kbps or 320kbps) at 44.100kHz.

The program automatically identifies music streaming from the user's browser by title, artist, and album, and displays the cover art after the song has been recorded. The music can be imported into iTunes and can be used on any digital device, such as iPhone, iPod, or iPad.

The program has two modes: Recording and Library. In the Recording mode the user sees an animated microphone, to which musical notes continuously float. The record state lights up red, the volume meter registers the sound range, and the timer indicates the length of the recording. At the bottom of the screen are a display of the most recent album covers.

In the Library mode the recorded songs are listed by title, time, artist, album, date added, and if the song has been properly identified, is indicated by a green check mark. Identified songs also have additional information displayed in the track info window with the aforementioned metadata as well as the year, genre, and format. As a song is highlighted, its album artwork appears above it. Double-clicking a listing will play its track.

In the Library mode there is also access to the Music Toolkit, which includes a CD Burner, for the direct burning of songs that are dragged to it. As songs are dragged and dropped on the main CD Burner window, the accumulated time is displayed along with the amount of time remaining on the CD media.

Among the many new features is Auto Smart Tone, which enables the user to apply a personal look or style based on adjustments in the color tone of a clip. The feature can be applied automatically, or can be fine-tuned using the Custom setting. In the Custom view, thumbnail images of tone variations appear in each corner of the clip frame. Moving the setting button in the direction of a corner applies that level of tone to the clip. The setting is applied to subsequent clips, and with continued use, Auto Smart Tone can learn the user's tonal preferences.

Perhaps the most significant new feature is video adjustment layers, similar in concept to the powerful adjustment layers in Photoshop Elements. Working in Expert mode the user selects the Effects icon and drags one of the many effects onto a clip in the timeline. The user is presented with the option to apply the effect only to the target clip, or to the



entire movie. In the timeline an Adjustment Layer is created and affects any clip that is below it. Using the Adjustments panel, the layer appearance can be edited in regard to Color (hue, lightness, saturation, and vibrance), Gamma, Temperature and Tint, and more.

Among the enhanced features are additional Hollywood effects and styles that can produce looks like a hand-drawn comic, or an old movie. Also added are more than 50 musical scores that automatically conform to the length of a video, and more than 250 sound effects for dramatic or comic mood. Green Screen (also known as ChromaKey) is the effect in which the user can control the transparency and fade levels of a specific color, in this case green, to produce a transparent mask. This process is commonly used in photographic settings to isolate the foreground image and replace the newly produced transparent pixels with a substitute image. Green Screen software commonly provides specialized tools to deal with image irregularities, such as inconsistent lighting and objectionable image artifacts. It can provide exceptional control over maintaining fine detail in the foreground image, such as strands of hair, smoke, glass, and other transparent and semi-transparent elements.

The benefits of green screen photography are many, and are used extensively in cinema, television production, advertising, and digitally composited still photography. Among the major advantages are:

- Background scenes are totally separate from foreground characters and/or objects, providing great flexibility in placement, positioning, and special effects.
- Background and foreground image capture can be conducted independently, by separate production crews, and without regard for physical distance.
- Scenes involving dangerous or unpredictable elements can be photographed as background, without exposing foreground talent, or expensive props, to harm or damage.
- Inexpensive stock images, which are readily available, can be used a backgrounds, avoiding the costs of on-site production.
- Backgrounds and foregrounds can be changed or modified quickly, providing digital compositors with an extensive array of options.

The best-in-class still image green-screening application we have found is PhotoKey 6 Pro, a highly versatile program that addresses all elements of green screen production workflow. PhotoKey 6 Pro provides a full arsenal of specialized tools, controls, filters, and related functions honed for producing professional product and event shots, portraits, catalog entries, posters, web media, and sophisticated creative composites. Also included is a Photoshop plug-in.

Although PhotoKey 6 Pro is highly sophisticated, and can meet the demands of the most critical user, it is so intelligently designed, and utilizes the most accurate, yet forgiving, green screen algorithms, that almost anyone can produce acceptable output.

When the PhotoKey 6 Pro application is opened it displays the Home view, where the user can access saved projects, view video tutorials, read the latest related news and social media postings, and learn about the latest version of the software. The three main application tabs are Home, Edit, and Help. Selecting either New Project, or Edit, the user will be presented with the Canvas set-up options.

The PhotoKey 6 Pro workflow begins with the definition of the canvas (FIG I), or work area, specifications. Several presets are provided of common output sizes, and a choice of portrait or landscape mode, although the user can set a custom size and resolution, based on the intended use of the image, either for screen or print.



The main parts of the program are listed in the Toolset, which can be positioned on the left or right side of the screen by using the Options window (FIG. 2). The Toolset (FIG. 3) lists the major parts of the software in the order that they might be used, although the user is free to select whatever option they need at any time.



In any case, the next option will be Import, with the purpose of importing both the foreground and background images. As the foreground image is imported, PhotoKey 6 Pro automatically, and with exceptional finesse, removes, or masks, the areas occupied by the green screen (FIG. 4). The green screen removal, as well as other fine adjustments, can be made using the Key options (FIG 5).



After the background image has been imported (FIG photokey background import) it can be adjusted using the Position option, which provides control of the horizontal and vertical placement, scaling, rotation, and horizontal and vertical flip.





It is not uncommon for there to be areas of the foreground image that are not covered by the green screen, due to the limited physical size of the green screen, or factors related to the rigging. In such cases, the Masks option gives the user the capability to cover unwanted areas by adding one or more masks. Masks are applied by selecting the Add Mask button, and then outlining the unwanted areas by clicking moveable control points (FIG. 6). Each click of the mouse sets one control point. When the last control point is clicked over the first control point, the mask is complete, and unwanted areas are cleared (FIG. 7). Additional masks can be created until all unwanted image elements are eliminated. The control points can be moved by clicking and dragging, to refine the shape of a mask.

The Filters option provides a long list of precision adjustable filters that can be applied to either the foreground or background image, or both, inde-

pendently. These include transparency, white balance, auto levels, auto color, brightness, contrast, saturation, levels, color temperature, color balance, hue colorize, hue shift, sharpen, blur, bilateral blur, defocus, diffuse, vibrance, leave color, halftone, halftone color, silhouette, and shadow cast (FIG. 8).




The foreground and the background comprise two layers, but the Layers option provides the means to add additional layers (FIG. 9). This feature enables the user to add more elements, to create a more sophisticated digital composite that can be modified using the Effects options to generate an overall blur, bleach, vignette, sepia, or other special effect. In addition, the Overlay options provides for applying a partially transparent image.





The Text options provide for adding text and setting its parameters, including font, line orientation (left, center, right), variation (bold, italic, underline), color, size, transparency, and angle (FIG. 10).

Exported images can be saved as PNG,TIFF, or JPEG, with the necessary level of compression and quality, and with an embedded workspace color

profile. Workflow flexibility is expanded considerably with the program's batch processing features, which both involve the use of a hot folder for the automatic import of added images, and the export of multiple foreground and background combinations. 

Adobe Ink & Slide are a set of hardware consisting of a fine-tip pressure-sensitive, single-button pen; and a ruler, that work with an iPad (iPad Air, iPad 4, and iPad Mini (Retina Display)) to enable accurate and highly refined drawings and sketches, from architectural to artistic. Along with a Creative Cloud account, and Adobe's new, free Adobe Line and Adobe Sketch apps, the user can access their digital assets and color themes no matter where they are working.

Ink is charged by plugging it into the magnetic base and connecting the micro USB cable to a source. As it charges, the LED ring pulses red...when fully charged the LED ring pulses through a spectrum of colors. Ink is set up both with a name and a color, to identify it when used in a collaborative setting. A writing style is also selected based on the way the user holds the pen. Finally the pen is linked to the user's CC account and email.

The Slide requires no set-up nor charging. When placed on an iPad screen it is recognized in either Line or Sketch, and its features are automatically available. Lines appear on the iPad in relation to the position of the Slide, and are converted from traceable guides to actual lines by using lnk. The button on the Slide summons either straight lines, or a circle, square, or triangle. A variety of trace packs are also available for drawing curves, polygons, and other elements. A series of stamp packs provides immediate placement of items, such as chairs, trees, and animals, that can stamped in place, resized, and moved. Photoshop CC (2014) introduces several significant productivity enhancements including: Blur Gallery motion effects to apply a blur along a path or to create a circular or elliptical blur; Focus Mask (a remarkable magic capability) that can automatically select the in-focus areas of an image and convert it into an instant mask; Smarter Smart Guides that both align and set elements at exact distances from one another; Photoshop Generator, a new plug-in, enables users to generate instances of composed assets located on one or more layers, in a choice of sizes and file formats; fast, intelligent upsampling of low-res images with detail and sharpness preserved; expanded its Photoshop 3D printing capabilities to include more accurate renderings with WYSIWYG previews, and output to additional 3D printers and service providers; and more.

Font workflow has been totally revamped to make it the most powerful, yet easy-to-use, font assignment capability ever produced. Users can get an instant real-time preview of any font in their font menu, in position, for any selected text. Users can view by font, or by font family, and can easily search by font name, such as Caslon, or design features, such as bold condensed. In addition, users have access to Adobe TypeKit, a diverse library of fonts created by Adobe master designers. Selected fonts can be used with any Adobe application, and can be substituted, automatically, for any missing fonts as files are opened.

InDesign CC (2014) now has more fluid table-making capabilities enabling drag-and-drop ease to move rows and columns; e-books can be exported in fixed-layout EPUB format to retain the look of the composed pages, yet retain live text; colors can be maintained in color swatch groups making organization and location of color themes easier; finished, or work in progress projects, can be exported directly to Behance for showcasing or for feedback; search has been enhanced to enable backward searching with "find previous,"; QR codes are now generated automatically after a data merge; and more.

Lightroom 5 (2014) can straighten tilted images with a single click using the new Upright tool; the Radial filter enables selective adjustments to simulate painting with light with localized control over exposure, contrast, clarity, sharpness, and other slide bar settings; Smart Previews allows users to make edits on small preview versions of



offline files, and have them updated on the source files when next connected; videos can now be composed as part of a Slide Show; Lightroom mobile can sync with Lightroom 5 desktop using Creative Cloud; highlights, shadows, whites and blacks can be fine-tuned with a real-time clipping preview; advanced black-and-white conversion by mixing eight color channels; improved and expanded Selective Adjustment Brush controls; and much more.

Illustrator CC (2014) features new Live Shapes with modifiable corners and independent radius control; Pen tool and anchor point improvements that significantly reduce path cleanup; disengagement of anchor handles from pixel, grid, or point snapping; automatic replacement of missing fonts using Typekit; and more.

Astropad is a two-app system, one for the Mac and one for the iPad, developed by two former Apple engineers, that enables the use of an iPad, running iOS 8.0 or greater, as a digital drawing surface for a Mac. The link between the Mac and iPad can be initiated either by WiFi or USB. A key feature of the application is the synchronization speed, called "LIQUID," between the two devices, providing instantaneous response, and therefore a natural on-screen drawing experience similar to that of an expensive dedicated drawing tablet.

The app provides for the selection of an area on the Mac screen that will appear on the iPad. That area is mirrored on the iPad, and enables the user to use either finger touch or a stylus to execute menu selections, movement, and edits. 

PhotoZoom Pro 6 disproves the long held adage that images cannot be enlarged without creating objectionable artifacts. With an impressive maximum image size of up to I million by I million pixels, images can be processed using a unique patented image processing technology called S-Spline Max (among others), which maintains clean edges, image sharpness, and fine detail, for both on-screen and print output. The program is available both as a standalone application and a plug-in for Adobe Photoshop and other popular host programs.

PhotoZoom Pro 6 is also able to enlarge JPEG images that contain noise and compression artifacts, actually reducing distortions as the images are magnified. In addition to the predefined processing settings, users can create their own, or modify existing definitions, greatly reducing workflow time. The batch processing capability makes use of multi-processor, 64-bit, and GPU acceleration, to handle exceptionally large quantities of images at one time.

The split-screen options enable the user to see a selected portion of the image both before and after processing, providing almost instant feedback, and an impressive view of what the program is capable of producing. The results are amazingly good.

Alfred 2 for Mac

Nearly all of the control that a digital publisher has over the creation of a publication is expressed through the use of the keyboard and the mouse. Users have recognized that certain operations are executed more efficiently through the use of the keyboard. There are several reasons for this. First, the use of the mouse requires that the user remove a hand from the keyboard, and ultimately place that hand back in position. This is most apparent

during the process of creating text, wherein there is likely to be a continual cycle of moving from the keyboard to the mouse and back again. These cycles can be time-consuming. Second, many of the menu options that are selected with the mouse are located several layers deep. This means that the user must navigate through two or more menu levels, or dialog boxes, to find a given option. This too is time-consuming, and depending on the complexity of the program, may require that the user have an intimate familiarity with the location of each and every option. A partial solution is the use of keyboard shortcuts, or keyboard equivalents, which produce with keystrokes the same operations that are produced by making selections with the mouse. Even small increments of time saved over prolonged periods can result in significant gains in productivity.

Certainly, most digital publishers are familiar with the keystrokes required to execute a Copy/Paste command. Although Copy and Paste are readily available within the Edit menu of virtually every application, many users tend to use the keyboard for this recurring operation. Why? Because it's faster.

Keyboard equivalents are more pervasive than most people might think. Most programs have them, and sophisticated programs such as Adobe InDesign have hundreds. According to the Adobe InDesign user manual, "You can use almost any feature in Adobe InDesign without using the mouse. InDesign provides a vast array of shortcuts that help you quickly maneuver through and alter a document."

Alfred 2 for Mac provides an immediately accessible portal through which users can manage files and applications, launch routine commands, and execute sophisticated user-defined workflows all through the use of the keyboard. The power of Alfred 2 is released with the Powerpack, an extra-cost set of capabilities that make Alfred 2 an essential tool for power users.

Invoking Alfred 2 at any time is done by pressing a hotkey combination, which is Option-Space by default. The user can change that to any key combination that is easy to remember, and which does not conflict with another preset, by opening the Preferences window. Alfred's Preferences are accessible directly from the Alfred icon in the menu bar, or from within the Alfred portal window, by clicking on the gear icon in the upper right corner.

The versatility of Alfred 2 is quite literally awesome. From simple macro expansions and file searches, to complex and highly sophisticated automated workflows, the program excels in its range of capabilities.

Among the productivity features that can be accomplished, simply and easily with Alfred 2 are:

Launching applications, files, and folders; initiating System commands; controlling iTunes or a streaming music service such as Spotify; executing multi-step workflows; creating Clipboard Snippets (macros); accessing Clipboard history; quickly searching for files or file content; getting a weather forecast; sending a tweet; inputting calculations; force quitting an



application; integrating I Password bookmarks; running Terminal commands; generating large type for ease in reading small print; and hundreds of other useful actions created by other Alfred users, such as determining if a site is down; generating random Lipsum text for dummy columns; creating a DMG file; tracking a package; converting an image to a different format; shortening a URL; and many, many more.

Workflows can be created without the need for any coding, and can be generated from examples, templates, or from scratch. In essence, a workflow consists of a trigger, likely a keyword, and one or more actions that will result. As workflows are constructed they appear as objects that are connected with lines using the user's intended logic. Workflows created by colleagues or from online sources can be installed into Alfred simply by double-clicking them. A generous number of Alfred workflows are available at no cost from a variety of websites.

Alfred Remote, is a companion program for iOS devices that interfaces with Alfred 2 for Mac. The program, which connects via Wi-Fi, appears on-screen as swipeable pages of icons, each of which, when tapped, executes an action on the Macintosh. The remote pages are created directly on the Mac, and appear instantly on the iOS device. The pages of icons can represent folders, files, apps, browser bookmarks, System preferences, or custom workflows. Using a Remote Trigger (i.e. pressing a workflow icon) can launch a series of multiple tasks either configured by the user or copied from a large collection of user-submitted actions.

The free version of Alfred 2 is available at http://www.alfredapp.com/. Every digital publisher and serious Mac user should at the very least download the free version and try it. The Powerpack feature bundle is priced reasonably at about \$26, and Alfred Remote. available from the App Store. is \$4.99.





Windows RDP (Remote Desktop Protocol), as defined by Microsoft, supports bidirectional sound, printing, file transfer, and clipboard synchronization, supporting easy Windows PC access from a Mac. The software has been tested and approved for use with RealVNC, xIIvnc, UltraVNC, TigerVNC, TightVNC, and VMWare.



The included Remotix Cloud ensures that computers can be accessed, even if they are located behind a firewall or NAT. The Remotix Cloud web interface enables remote computer management and messaging, and makes it possible to quickly connect with a remote user with only a Computer ID and Access Code, requiring no setup at the initiating end. Single non-commercial licenses are \$39.99; single commercial use licenses are \$79.99, available with volume discounts; and a single site license is \$499.



Mr. Rimmer, a Canadian graphic artist, under the direction of Richard Kegler, demonstrates the laborious process of designing a new typeface, RTF Stern (issued by Richard Kegler's P22 type foundry), and producing it using both traditional and modern workflows.

Bonus features on the DVD include in-depth coverage of each of the hot metal production steps, as well as the newly digitized silent film: The Creation of a Printing Type from the Design to The Print by Frederic W. Goudy, a Paramount Picture presented by Adolph Zukor. Also included is a piece of metal type cast from the "k" matrix cut by Jim Rimmer.
